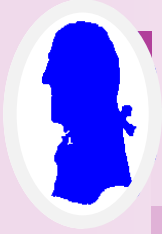

Dear Residents,

Firstly, we would like to thank all those residents whom signed our petition requesting LBTH to rectify our CCTV on the estate. According to the Management Agreement which they signed in February 2016, it clearly stated that they are obliged to maintain this service. Our Solicitors remain involved too and following a recent estate walkabout organised by Cllr McQuillan, we received assurances of progress in this area.

We are also awaiting further news from Tower Hamlets Homes over proposed lighting improvements which we feel is needed so our estate is both safer and brighter. The TMC has offered to fund this much needed works out of our own efficiencies/surplus monies in order to have this in place before the autumn. We are still receiving reports of persons, not from our estate, acting in an anti-social manner and it is vital that residents call the ASB line on 0207 364 5015 as it will help us receive more visits from the Police/Park Guards.

We will be starting a program of deep cleaning in the blocks and we have also arranged for the communal windows to be cleaned simultaneously. Caretakers are busy jetting forecourts and the Community Payback teams are concentrating on painting bollards and trimming back hedges. We are delighted that the open top commercial bins that so blighted our estate looking ugly and attracting fly tipping have been replaced by street door collections with bins supplied by the TMC.

The hot weather did not stop our growers in the communal garden of which this is our best season so far whilst we are delighted that all plots are being used. We are pleased to announce that the Margate trip later on in the month is now fully booked.









At the end of September we are due to hold our AGM where candidates from the estate will be giving the opportunity to be elected on the TMC Management Committee.
