What the TMC is doing — The TMC is playing its part to help support residents during these difficult times. A budget has been agreed by the management committee to install radiator reflectors in tenanted properties. These reflectors are installed behind radiators which are on the external walls to help keep the heat in. This scheme is currently being rolled out. We are also replacing the bathroom lights with LED lights in tenanted flat which will also help reduce running costs.


