Please note the trips are for Bancroft residents only and priority will be given to tenants and resident leaseholders on a 'first come first serve' basis.

**CCTV** – The newly upgraded cameras have been fitted on the five existing CCTV poles and two new cameras have been installed in the Braintree/Doveton/Wickford Square giving estate wide coverage. The cameras are due to go live shortly, and it is hoped that this will act as an effective deterrent to those engaging in nuisance while reducing incidents of anti-social behaviour and fly tipping.

**Major Works Programme –** Works have been completed in Sceptre House. Colebert House is due be completed by the end of June and preparatory works are currently taking place in Pemell House which will also involve a roof renewal.

**Condensation, Damp & Mould –** During the colder months, most homes get small patches of mould. If the cause is left untreated mould can grow and spread very quickly.

Mould can be managed by reducing moisture in the air, ventilation, and heating. You will find some useful tips on the following link

**Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)** – Following the recent increase in vehicle and illegal drug related ASB outside blocks we are working with stakeholders and have asked for additional patrols on the estate from Tower Hamlets Enforcement Officers.

When reporting an incident, it is helpful if you can identify the location ASB is taking place, the type of ASB, how many people involved, what time they arrive/leave and what they are doing. It is helpful if you can provide as much information as possible as this helps the ASB team to arrange patrols when the ASB is most likely to be occurring. Please be assured that any information you provide will remain confidential.

Unless residents come forward and report incidents when they take place, the action we can take may be limited, therefore, your help in this matter could make all the difference.

**Better Bethnal Green Community Consultation –** We continue to work with the Osmani Trust to secure funding from the Mayor of London, Violence Reduction Unit to deliver activities for youth. They are currently carrying out a community consultation around issues of concerns in the area and will be doing some detached work.
