Drug Related ASB

The dealing of drugs is a serious criminal offence and needs to be reported to the police in the first instance. You can report this to the police by:

When reporting as incident, it is helpful if you can provide as much information as possible such as the location ASB is taking place, the type of ASB, how many people are involved, what time they arrive/leave and what they are doing. This helps the ASB team to arrange patrols when the ASB is most likely to be occurring. Please be assured that any information you provide will remain confidential.
